

Current Job Posting Trends¹

Dudley Overview

- Between April to June 2025 (inclusive), there were 6,157 unique job postings for roles recorded in Dudley. This number of postings is high compared to all local authority districts. Over the past year, this has decreased by 5.3%, compared to a decrease of 2.3% across the UK.
- During this period, there were 4,589 new job postings. This number of postings is average compared to all local authority districts. Over the past year, this has decreased by 7.0% compared to a decrease of 2.5% nationally.

Demand and Interest Trend:



- Comparing the final week of the quarter with the same week at the start of the quarter, live postings have decreased by 6.6%, whilst new job postings have decreased by 7.5%. This downward trend over the quarter would suggest that demand by employers is decreasing.
- More recent trends show an increase in demand as live postings increased by 7.9% in the last 30 days of job posting activity, new postings also increased by 12.0% showing a recovery in labour market demand following a drop at the start of the quarter.
- By comparing interest quotient and demand, we can identify where there are mismatches in talent/supply and demand. Interest Quotient is ranked high at 1.6.

Dudley Advertised Salary

• The advertised median salary for roles over this period in Dudley was £34,465 – up by 14.3% from the previous year, but 5.1% less than the overall national median salary of £36,315.

Top Occupations

- The top posted occupations below account for 13.4% of all job postings in this quarter.
- Maintenance Engineers are the most in demand occupations, reporting the highest number of postings in Dudley.
- Positions for Social Care Workers and Healthcare Support Worker were the most in demand vacancies from the employee perspective, receiving the highest interest in terms of clicks and applicants.
- Maintenance Engineer has the highest location quotient while Science teacher (Secondary School)
 has the highest salary.


Skills most requested in postings in Dudley, 01/04/2025 - 30/06/2025

• By volume Dudley Council have logged the most job postings, followed by Barchester Healthcare and Dudley College.



Dudley Total Claimants²

 Dudley had 9,670 claimants aged 16 years and over in June 2025, an increase of 105 claimants (+1.1%) compared to the previous month. Compared to June 2024, claimants in Dudley increased by 440 (+4.8%).


- Out of the 24 wards within Dudley, 14 were above the UK average of 3.1%.
- The wards with the highest number of claimants as a percentage of residents aged 16 years and over were St Thomas's at 8.0%, followed by St James's at 5.9% and Castle & Priory at 5.8%

Dudley Youth Claimants

Dudley had 1,855 youth claimants in June 2025, an increase of 10 (+0.5%) since May 2025. When compared to June 2024, the number of youth claimants increased by 115 (+6.6%).

- Challenges remain with youth claimants as 15 out of 24 wards in Dudley were above the UK average of 4.3% in June 2025.
- The wards with the highest number of claimants as a percentage of residents aged 16-24 were St Thomas's at 9.9%, Castle & Priory at 9.7% and Brockmoor & Pensnett at 8.1%.
