

Current Job Posting Trends¹

Walsall Overview

- Between April to June 2025 (inclusive), there were 5,467 unique job adverts for roles recorded in Walsall. This number of postings is average compared to all local authority districts. Over the past year, this has decreased by 16.7%, compared to a decrease of 2.3% across the UK.
- During this period, there were 4,060 unique job postings. This number of postings is average compared to all local authority districts. Over the past year, this has decreased by 18.3%, compared to a decrease of 2.5% across the UK.

Demand and Interest Trend:



- Comparing the final week of the quarter with the same week at the start of the quarter, live postings have increased by 1.9% while new job postings decreased by 6.0%.
- More recent trends show an increase in demand as live postings increased by 14.1% in the last 30 days of job posting activity, new postings also increased by 8.6% showing a recovery in labour market demand following a decline at the start of the quarter.
- By comparing interest quotient and demand, we can identify where there are mismatches in talent/supply and demand. Interest Quotient is ranked high at 1.4.

Walsall Advertised Salary

• The advertised median salary for roles over this period in Walsall was £35,956 – up by 7.2% from the previous year but 1.0% less than the overall national median salary of £36,315.

Top Occupations

- The top posted occupations below account for 14.0% of all job postings in this quarter.
- Teachers are the most in demand occupations, receiving the highest number of postings in Walsall.
- Positions for Managers were the most in demand vacancies from the employee perspective, receiving the highest interest in terms of clicks and applicants.
- Science Teachers (Secondary School) have the highest location quotient and the highest salary.




Most In-Demand Skills


Skills most requested in postings in Walsall, 01/04/2025 - 30/06/2025

• Over the quarter Walsall Council logged the most job postings, followed Homeserve.



Walsall Total Claimants²

 Walsall had 11,000 claimants aged 16 years and over in June 2025, an increase of 330 (+3.1%) claimants from the previous month. Compared to June 2024, claimants in Walsall increased by 800 (+7.8%).


- Out of the 20 wards within Walsall, 14 were at or above the UK average of 3.1%.
- The wards with the highest number of claimants as a percentage of residents aged 16 years and over were Pleck at 9.2%, Palfrey at 8.5% and Blakenall at 7.7%.

Walsall Youth Claimants

Walsall had 2,290 youth claimants in June 2025, an increase of 70 youth claimants (+3.2%) compared to the previous month. When compared to June 2024, the number of youth claimants increased by 205 (+9.8%).

- Challenges remain with youth claimants as 16 out of 20 wards in Walsall were above the UK average of 4.3% in June 2025.
- The wards with the highest number of claimants as a percentage of residents aged 16-24 were Blakenall at 12.3%, Birchills Leamore at 12.0% and Bloxwich East at 11.5%.
